This funding will be used to

- Provide teachers with observation/feedback, mentoring/coaching.
- Allow teachers to participate in the full moderation cycle with particular emphasis on the Collaborative Assessment of Student Work and Case Management of student work.
- Commence building teacher knowledge and understanding of the general capabilities and crosscurriculum priorities and how they are embedded in learning.
- Strengthen the consistency of the implementation of identified effective pedagogical practices and high impact teaching strategies.
- Strengthen the use of formative data to identify ways to provide feedback to students on their learning and inform changes in pedagogy.

Our initiatives include

- Developing teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-12 Australian Curriculum Content Descriptions and Achievement Standards through refining and embedding processes for robust intraschool and inter-school moderation.
- Providing targeted professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the delivery of the Australian Curriculum and assisting them to make connections between subject areas.
- Continue to build capability and schoolwide consistency around 'data literacy' to support teachers and leadership teams to effectively use data to inform targeted teaching and next steps in learning.
- Consolidate a whole school approach to differentiated teaching and learning, which includes collaborative assessment of student work samples, individual student case management and intensive support systems.
- Refine teacher capability and pedagogy to provide a whole school approach to diffentiated teaching and learning, through collegial discussions, coach, learning walks and Professional Development Plans.
- Providing focussed and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year level achievement standards.
